Hi Guilherme.

I apologize for the very late delay in getting back to you.

The intent of section 2.3.5 is to generally prohibit the use of lead as a part of the payload unless required for specific functional needs. The use of lead, even when encapsulated, as a payload "dead weight" mass generally violates the spirit of this requirement. We would ask that your payload be constructed entirely of steel which represents a volume more representative of a typical payload size.
